Why This Calendar?

In Green Valley's warm climate, pests stay active all year. Use this guide to protect your health and home with seasonal tips made for retirees.



Spring (March–May)

Watch for:

-  Termites – Start swarming
-  Rodents – Nest in garages
-  Spiders – Active in warm corners




What to Do:

- Inspect for wood damage
- Clear out storage areas
- Schedule seasonal pest inspection



Summer (June–August)

Watch for:




-  Scorpions – Hide in shoes and bathrooms
-  Mosquitoes – More biting after monsoons
-  Ants – Invade kitchens and patios

What to Do:

- Shake out laundry and shoes
- Remove standing water
- Keep doors and windows sealed

Fall (September–November)

Watch for:




-  Rodents – Move indoors
-  Spiders – Webs in corners
-  Ants – Trails in bathrooms and pantries

What to Do:

- Store food in sealed containers
- Block garage and attic entry points
- Declutter unused spaces

Winter (December–February)

Watch for:

-  Mice – Chew wires and insulation
-  Cockroaches – Nest near sinks and warmth
-  Spiders – Stay hidden indoors

What to Do:

- **Clean under sinks and behind appliances**
- **Check storage areas**
- **Consider indoor treatments**
